

English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESL)

School Year Classes Online and/or In Person, new students welcome any time.

ESL Levels A, B and C

Day/Evening in Dover or Rochester: (6-wk Summer program avail) Learn vocabulary, grammar, reading, writing, and conversation to improve your English skills.

Civics Reading & Discussion

New students welcome anytime. Some reading and a lot of discussion, pronunciation, grammar, vocabulary, and sharing ideas.

Conversation Group

New students welcome anytime. Practice English language pronunciation, vocabulary, conversation, and listening.

Short Courses

Such as Punctuation or Grammar; will vary by semester, 8-Week Sessions, Fall or Spring.

U.S. Citizenship

(Online) Learn about US government, history, and the responsibilities of democratic life. Curriculum based on US citizenship application and test questions.

Advanced ESL Classes

Such as Short Story, Drama or TOEFL Prep; will vary by semester Tuition: \$15 (\$10 for Dover residents).

Academic & Employability Skills (Dover or Rochester)

Essential skills for high school completion, college readiness, employment, advancement or job training. Day and evenings classes.

Math: Improve math confidence, computational skills, and number sense. Develop pre-algebra, algebra, geometry and problem solving skills. Practice test questions for HiSET and ACCUPLACER.

Reading: Develop comprehension, vocabulary and grammar skills. Gain critical thinking skills, including interpreting, analyzing and synthesizing information from many sources.

Writing: Write stronger sentences and paragraphs to better communicate ideas and information. Learn a variety of forms.

*Biology: 15-Week Sessions, fall/spring, (tuition varies)
*Chemistry: 15-Week Sessions, fall/spring (tuition varies)
*Algebra: Tuition \$60, self-guided, 1 math credit
Economics: Tuition \$30, self-guided, .5 social studies credit
U.S. History: Tuition \$60, self-guided, 1 U.S. history credit.
